All public pools and spas in Fayette County are **required** by regulation to have *at least one* (1) certified pool operator on duty during the hours of operation.

Facilities may certify as many as they require. *It is recommended at least two (2) persons are certified per facility.*

Lexington-Fayette County regulations state that the \$35 pool and spa operator fee **must be paid annually**. The class **must be attended every other year**.

If you passed the class in 2024, you must pay the \$35 renewal fee to receive an updated certificate expiring in 2026.

If you only paid the renewal fee in 2024, you must pay the \$35 class fee **AND** attend, with a passing exam score, to receive an updated certificate expiring in 2026.

This course is designed to provide guidelines for the safe operation of swimming pools and spas. As more swimming and specialized aquatic facilities are built, there is increased need for professionally trained operators.

These operators must have the technical knowledge and practical experience necessary to fulfill these requirements. Pool owners, managers, and maintenance personnel are encouraged to attend.
